



Buenos Aires - Paris of Latin America

- Tango, soccer, steak, Evita, Borges, Malbec and more.
- Safe, lovely city in a beautiful country with one of the worst managed economies in the world
- Recurrent economic challenges
 - Inflation over 50% and a recession
 - Rapidly depreciating exchange rate and now exchange controls
 - High export and import tariffs
 - Price controls on some basic products
 - Budget deficit is about 5% of GDP
 - \$56 billion loan from the IMF (about its 30th loan)
 - May default on \$115 billion in foreign currency bonds

Japan - US Relationship

- Japan is US's 4th largest goods export market
- Japanese government actively welcomes & solicits foreign direct (FDI).
- The US-Japan Alliance:
 - Cornerstone of US security interest in Asia
 - Key to regional stability & prosperity
 - 43 U.S. military bases (75% in Okinawa)
 - 5,000 US troops


GRP Student Experience


